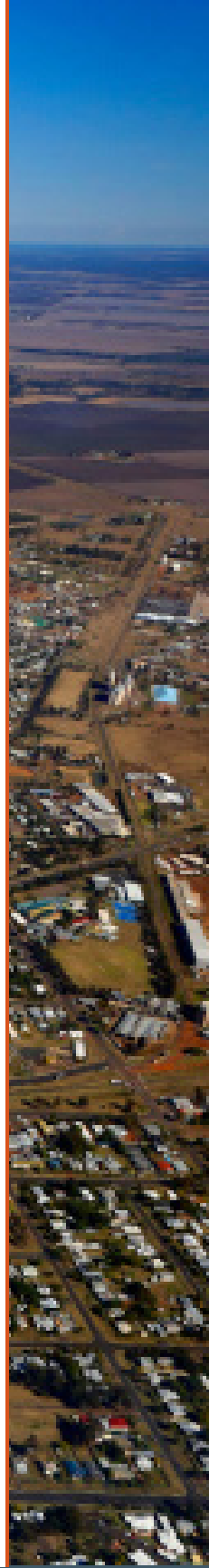

Hard work, innovation and embracing opportunity are the founding principles of the Western Downs, and today, we are a diverse region at the forefront of a changing world.

Just two and a half hours from Brisbane, and only an hour from Toowoomba Wellcamp Airport, the Western Downs offers the benefits of spacious regional life with great connectivity.

This proximity affords the region amazing growth and development opportunities as Queenslanders continue to migrate. Residents know well that this place is something special.

People seek great liveability and follow opportunity, two things that our region offers residents, businesses and investors.

For a small region of just 35,000 people, our region produces a significant share of critical goods and services for Australian and international markets.

Our strong, diverse economy has long been built on the economic pillars of agriculture and intensive agriculture, bolstered by the rise of our manufacturing and energy sectors.

The Western Downs is the heart of Australia's beef production, with a massive 42% of the national feedlot capacity located within 200 kilometres of Dalby Saleyards.

This facility sells more than 200,000 cattle each year, making it the largest same-day prime and store cattle yards in the country.

The Western Downs is proudly 'The Energy Capital of Queensland' and we are leaders in wind, solar, hydrogen, coal and gas energy, producing power for more than two million Australians.

Our energy mix harnesses traditional and renewable power generation, with our region leading the way in renewable project investment.

We have approved 24 solar farms in the region and, in addition to this, new projects including Dulacca Wind Farm and Wambo Wind Farm developments and the renewables-based hydrogen plant at CS Energy's Kogan Creek Power Station.

As a Council, we are focused on investment attraction, progressive liveability endeavours, future-proofing our infrastructure and continued economic diversification to fortify the future of the Western Downs.

Council is actively advocating the State and Federal Governments for the development of Nathan Dam as a new source of long-term water security and sustain future growth in our agriculture, manufacturing, resource and energy sectors.

We have also committed \$45 million over three years for development of a bore, water treatment and pipeline for Dalby.

Land developers in the region can also take advantage of a new \$5 million Housing and Land Development incentive which makes it extremely profitable to invest in housing on the Western Downs.

With delivering first-rate essential services and great liveability infrastructure front of mind, Council continues to deliver region-building projects including a revitalisation of the Dalby CBD, which includes construction of a Cultural Centre, a new Chinchilla Aquatic Centre and Jandowae's Central Park Fence.

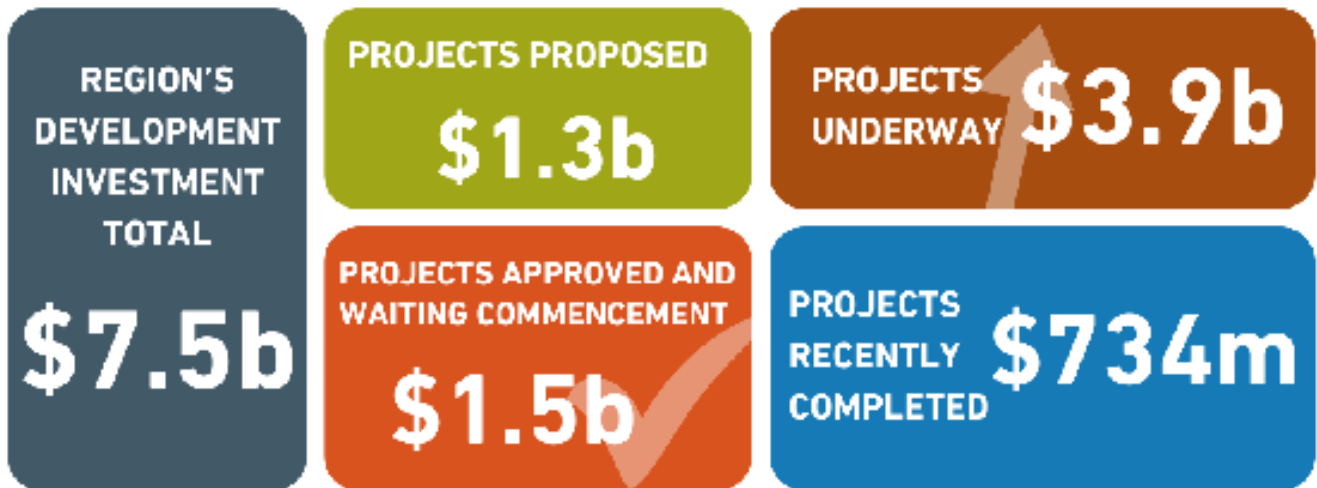
The future looks bright for the Western Downs with significant opportunities and major projects on the development horizon and billions worth of investment already in the pipeline.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Western Downs Region stands out as a driver of regional development in Queensland with a community minded approach ensuring positive outcomes for its residents. The Western Downs Development Status Report has identified just over \$7.5 billion in development across various stages and industries within in the region, demonstrating the investment and employment opportunity for this expanding area.

The projects compiled within this report have been categorised as per the following:



Private construction, civil works and public service industries continue to create local employment opportunities and skills-based training for Western Downs residents whilst ensuring continued growth of the region and its facilities. Investment in proposed and underway projects in these industries has been identified with majority in community use projects, public healthcare and school infrastructure upgrades. Some of the notable projects include the proposed Tara Hospital construction with increased intake capabilities, expansive extensions to Chinchilla Christian College, new development of an aged care facility with an 81-bed capacity in Chinchilla, providing local jobs.

Increased interest in renewable energy investment has shown the region living up to its title as the 'Energy Capital of Queensland'. Totalling more than \$7 billion in proposed, underway and completed projects the sector employs a large number of the local population and works in collaboration with its landholders to position the Region as a renewables powerhouse. Major projects include the Wambo Wind Farm currently under construction at an investment of \$650 million with 42 towers. The natural gas sector also continues to deliver in its investment in Western Downs regionally based projects with over \$1 billion in proposed and underway constructions in predominantly pipeline development and expansion.

WESTERN DOWNS HOUSING AND LAND INCENTIVE

Western Downs Regional Council has increased its Housing and Land Incentive to **\$5 million**. Designed to encourage residents and developers with a vision to construct units or subdivide land to bring their projects to reality, this incentive will stimulate construction by offering generous application fee discounts and discounted infrastructure charges to approved developments across the region.
